- Student safety is a priority at Salem High School. We ask that all parents and visitors check in at the Administration Office upon arrival on school grounds.
- **Salem High School is a closed campus. Students are not allowed to leave at lunch and parents/others should not bring fast food on campus.**
- Parking tags need to be displayed in your vehicle. Students are subject to disciplinary consequences if you do not have a parking tag on your vehicle. The cost for the tag is \$5.00.
- School breakfast/lunch program: You are allowed \$5.00 in meal charges in the cafeteria. Ala Carte items cannot be charged, only a school meal.
- Students are reminded that due to MO law and Salem High School policy, students may not bring hunting weapons and/or ammunition on school property. This is considered a SAFE SCHOOLS Violation and subject to severe disciplinary consequences. Random parking lot sweeps will be conducted, especially during deer season, and any vehicle with visible weapons and/or ammunition will be considered in violation and subject to disciplinary action.
- Students are not allowed to move their vehicles during early dismissal for sports events.
- Students are not permitted to park in designated spots next to the Tin Gym that are between the Tin Gym and the White House – Technology Office. These parking spots are faculty/staff only. Per your handbook, student parking is to be in the student parking lot or along the road in front of the football field. The circle drive is also for faculty/staff and visitors only – no student parking. Students who violate these rules are subject to disciplinary action.
